



REMOTE LEARNING FOR ALL STUDENTS

The USD 261 Board of Education made the decision on Monday, November 9th to move ALL MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL students to REMOTE LEARNING. Starting Wednesday, November 18th students will be attending classes virtually using their Chromebooks at home. Students will follow their class schedule by logging into Google Meet for each hour. Students already have their class specific Google Meet codes for each of their teachers. The school day will start at 7:40 a.m. and end at 3:05 p.m. just as if they were sitting in their physical classroom.

REMOTE LEARNING EXPECTATIONS:

- Log in to every class at assigned time through Google Meet.
- Find a quiet place to work. (Away from distractions like television, bed, younger siblings, etc.)
- Students must have camera on and be visible to teacher.
- Engage and participate in all lessons and/or discussions.
- Complete your assignments in the time given and turn them in.
- Communicate with your teacher via email, chat, or Google Meet if you have any questions regarding classwork.
- All CHS students will have their lunch break from 10:53 – 11:18. Google Meet for 3rd Block will start at 11:18.
- School Handbook Rules still apply during remote learning, (examples: proper language, respect, no vaping)

HOW TO LOGIN FOR REMOTE LEARNING:

- Students have specific Google Meet codes for each of their teachers. For example, if your child has Mr. Smith for math 1st hour, they will go to that classes meet code on their Chromebook. All students have already practiced this and should be ready to attend school virtually starting Wednesday at 7:40 a.m. If your student still needs their meet code, they can call the high school office.
- We will have dedicated tech support staff in our building November 18-20 to help support your family during this transition to remote learning. Please call us if you are experiencing technical difficulties. We will be here to help.

REMOTE ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS:

Schools are required to take attendance by the State of Kansas even while Remote Learning is taking place. Students who do not log in to a class will be counted absent and parents will be contacted. If your child is ill and unable to log in to class, has an appointment or another obligation please contact our school office at 316-554-2236 so we can document the absence.
