The 2020 COVID-19 pandemic not only affects your own health, but it also affects the health and safety of your fellow workers, family and community members. Please follow these guidelines that have been recommended by the CDC for the well-being of all concerned.

**COMPLETE THE SELF-SCREENING  
PRIOR TO REPORTING TO WORK  
OR ENTERING A USD 261 FACILITY.**

Employees: If you answer "YES" to any of the following questions, you should stay home from work and follow the normal absence reporting procedures. Let your supervisor know if symptoms could be related to COVID-19.

Visitors, Vendors, and Volunteers: If you answer "YES" to any of the following questions, **DO NOT** enter the building.

## ARE YOU CURRENTLY EXPERIENCING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS?

- Fever greater than 100.4°F, 38°C
- Muscle or body aches
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell

**OR**

- Has there been an exposure to someone diagnosed with COVID-19, either household or non-household contact?
- Have you been advised by a healthcare provider or the county health department to self-quarantine?
- Have you traveled within the last 14 days to a state or country identified as a hot spot for COVID-19?
